The Board of County Commissioners of Thurston County, Washington, therefore declare said tract, to-wit, the following described property in Thurston County, Washington:

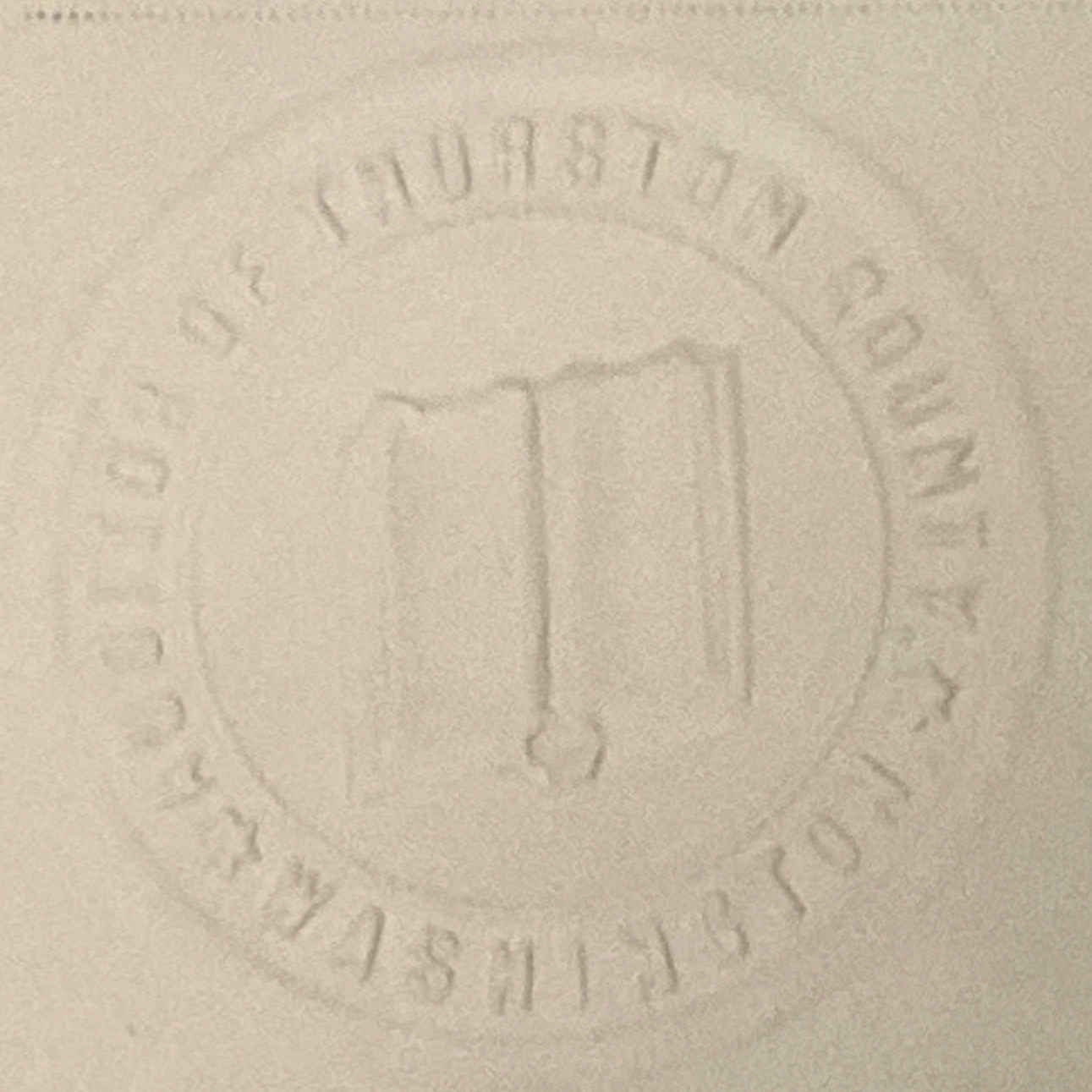
